Reflection on the readings for Palm Sunday, by Monsignor Robert Draper Mass: Is 50:4-7 Ps 21 Ph 2:6-11 Mk 14:1-15:47

At the beginning and at the end of this week the liturgy offers us two accounts of the Passion, and they could not be more contrasted...Mark is a bleak and sombre account – Jesus is abandoned, torn by grief and ridiculed by everyone. John's account is very different – Jesus is very much in control, aware of his purpose and dies with his mother and the beloved disciple with him...Many in any community may identify with a rejected and grief struck Jesus, feeling abandoned and alone, the reality of Christ's solidarity with humanity in all its frailty is at the heart of Mark's account. But all Christians can hear John's account and recognise that this is an account of the great triumph of Christ over the world and over sin and death.
